Welcome to Your Recycling Cart

In an effort to collect more recyclables, keep our communities clean and create more efficient collection routes, your municipality is moving to automated recycling collection using a new recycling cart. The lidded cart keeps materials dry and from blowing out on windy days. The carts are also designed to easily roll to the street or road. Further, the automated collection system increases the level of safety for route drivers. In all, everyone wins using carts for recycling!

Do I now have a new recycling collection schedule and when can I start using my cart? Your recycling day will not change, and you may start using your cart on your next scheduled collection day.

Can I place my recyclables in plastic bags?

NO, DO NOT place recyclables in plastic bags or put bags-of-bags in your cart. For information on local grocery and retail stores that accept shopping bags and other stretch film plastic for recycling, go to RecycleMoreOutagamie.org.

What should I do if my recycling does not fit in my cart?

All recyclables must fit inside the cart with the lid closed. If you have more recyclables than will fit, you should:

- Save them for your next collection day.
- Ask a neighbor if they have extra room in their cart for your recyclables.
- · Bring extra recyclables to the county's drop-off site located at 1419 Holland Road in Appleton.

How do I set my cart out on collection day?

Place your cart curbside before 6am the day of collection, with the cart's handle facing your house and the lid opening toward the street. Make sure there is at least four feet between the recycling and trash carts, and any other objects, such as a parked car or mailbox. Note, if your cart was set out late, you must wait until your next scheduled pick-up.

What if there is a snow bank?

In the case of snow, if your cart will not fit in your driveway opening, then you will need to clear an opening in the snow bank where the cart can be properly placed. Carts cannot be placed on top of the snow bank or in the road. Improperly placed carts will not be collected.


What if I have a very long driveway? How do I get my cart to the road?

What if my cart is damaged or needs repair?

If your cart is damaged or in need of repair as a result of normal wear and tear (e.g. broken lid, wheel, cracked cart, etc.), contact your municipality at (920) 450-3479.

PAPER

Accept

- · Milk, juice & soup cartons
- · Newspapers & inserts
- Cardboard & paperboard (cereal & cracker boxes)
- Phonebooks, books, magazines & catalogs
- Shredded paper placed in paper bag (secured & labled)



cut boxes to 2'x2' or smaller

Do Not Accept

NO food-contaminated paper

NO tissue

NO gift wrap

METAL & GLASS

Accept

- · Aluminum bottles & cans
- Steel, tin & bi-metal cans
- · Empty aerosol cans
- Food & beverage glass bottles & jars



empty & rinse all bottles & containers remove & discard all plastic caps

Do Not Accept

NO aluminum pans or foil

NO empty paint cans

NO glassware, windows or ceramics
