ATV/UTV Ordinance

Another topic from our last annual meeting was the township developing an ordinance around usage of ATV and UTVs on town roads. Finally, we can say, the town of Deer Creek has passed ordinance 19-01 to allow ATV/UTVs on all town roads starting on September 9th 2019 or when signs are posted. Outagamie County has been getting a lot of questions to open county roads for ATV/UTV use. They have commented they will have something together by the end of the year. Please remember, as this ordinance becomes effective, only town roads can be used and as soon as usage is allowed on county roads, we will post something on our website. Our ordinance has been approved by Wisconsin DNR, Outagamie County Sheriff's Department, and the Wisconsin State Patrol.



How the 2020 Census will invite everyone to respond



What to Expect in the Mail

When it's time to respond, most households will receive an invitation in the mail. Every household will have the option of responding online, by mail, or by phone.

Depending on how likely your area is to respond online, you'll receive either an invitation encouraging you to respond online or an invitation along with a paper questionnaire.

Letter Invitation

- Most areas of the country are likely to respond online, so most households will receive a letter asking you to go online to complete the census questionnaire.
- We plan on working with the U.S. Postal Service to stagger the delivery of these invitations over several days. This way we can spread out the number of users responding online, and we'll be able to serve you better if you need help over the phone.

Letter Invitation and Paper Questionnaire

 Areas that are less likely to respond online will receive a paper questionnaire along with their invitation. The invitation will also include information about how to respond online or by phone.

March 16-24	A reminder letter.

April 20-27	A final reminder postcard before we follow up in person.


We understand you might miss our initial letter in the mail.

How the 2020 Census will invite everyone to respond



Every household will have the option of responding online, by mail, or by phone.

Nearly every household will receive an invitation to participate in the 2020 Census from either a postal worker or a census worker.



95% of households will receive their census invitation in the mail.





Almost 5% of households will receive their census invitation when a census taker drops it off. In these areas, the majority of households may not receive mail at their home's physical location (like households that use PO boxes or areas recently affected by natural disasters).



Less than 1% of households will be counted in person by a census taker, instead of being invited to respond on their own. We do this in very remote areas like parts of northern Maine, remote Alaska, and in select American Indian areas that ask to be counted in person.

Note: We have special procedures to count people who don't live in households, such as students living in university housing or people experiencing homelessness.
