Garbage and recycling in Deer Creek

Every resident in the town of Deer Creek should have a recyclable and waste cart. These carts are owned by the township. If something breaks, becomes damaged or you never received carts, please contact clerk@townofdeercreek.wi.gov or call one of the board members.

Garbage and recycling carts should be placed at the end of your driveway by 6:00 a.m on the day of pick-up to ensure pick-up. Make sure cart opening is facing the road or your cart will not be emptied.

Recycling service is provided by Orion Waste Solutions. Recycling pick up is every other Friday. Check the town website as the calendar is updated with current garbage and recycling pick-up dates. Contact Orion Waste Solutions at 920-759-0501 if your pick up was missed.

Garbage pick-up is every Friday unless a major holiday (New Year's Day, Fourth of July or Christmas) falls on a Friday, then pick up will be on Saturday. If a pick up is missed, contact GFL at 920-982-4116. Here are some special circumstances to keep in mind about garbage pick-up:

1. Call GFL to schedule a pick-up and to get pricing for pickup of the following items: Electronics, furniture and appliances. Do not put these items at the roadside without consulting GFL first.
2. GFL will not accept liquid waste, building demolition materials, recyclable materials, yard waste, asbestos of any form, tires or motor oil.

Proposed Road Work for 2022

The Outagamie County Highway Department has plans to repair Hwy 76 Shiocton to Hwy 45 in 2023. This project will improve the existing asphaltic surface by pavement wedging and installing a new asphalt overlay for this segment of highway. Culvert replacements and spot ditching may also be included to improve overall roadway drainage.

STH 76 to CTH XX County D project delayed 1 year Design engineering commencing in March 2022. Design survey will be completed in spring followed by drainage analysis along the corridor and design of future drainage and roadway improvements. Construction anticipated as early as 2023.
